

Briefing meeting on Round I Admission Mechanism 2018-19



Admission Committee

- ❑ Processing Round I (re-admission) and Round II admission on behalf of the college Master.

- ❑ Committee Members
 - Deputy master
 - Senior tutor, tutors and honorary tutors
 - UG and PG student representatives from the college advisory committee.

Who needs to apply for Round I Admission?

- i. Current residents who wish to stay in the college next academic year.
- ii. Current residents who will be on exchange in the 1st semester of the next academic year but wish to return to the college in the 2nd semester.
- iii. Current residents who will be on exchange next academic year but wish to return to the college in the year after the next academic year.
- iv. Previous residents who are currently on exchange but wish to return to the college in the next academic year.

Important Dates

- April 7-13, 2018: Internal application period
- April 12-20, 2018: Official application period through HKU portal
- April 21(Sat) 28(Sat) 29(Sun), 2018: Tentative interview dates
- May 24, 2018: Result announcement of Round 1 Admission
- May 24-31, 2018: Acceptance of Offer period (Successful applicants)
- May 24-27, 2018: Appeal period (Unsuccessful applicants)
- May 28-June 3, 2018: Review of appeals
- June 4, 2018: Appeal results to students

Round I Admission Criteria

I. High table dinner (10%)

- *Number of Absence ≤ 1 , 2, ≥ 3 : 10, 5, 0 points*

II. Academic merit (45%)

- *GPA, Distinction/Pass/Fail, Prizes, Awards, Scholarship, Publications, etc...*

III. Extracurricular activities (45%)

- *Within the College*
- *Outside the College*

IV. Compliance with college rules.

V. Special needs (*e.g., medical reason, etc.*)

Successful rate for Round I admission

To be confirmed by the coming Governance Committee of JCSV3 on April 16, 2018.

- UG: ~60% (2017-18)
- PG: ~70% (2017-18)

FAQs

Q1. What's the successful rate for re-admission?

A : ~60% for UG, ~70% for PG required by the Governance Committee of JCSV3.

Q2. Will my extracurricular activities outside colleges be counted?

A : Yes, both extracurricular activities within and outside the college will be taken into consideration.

Q3. What if I am not in Hong Kong during the assigned interview time slot?

A : Skype interview can be arranged if you are not in HK.

FAQs

Q4. Will I stay in the same room or on the same floor if I get re-admitted?

A: You might be assigned to some other floor. You are not guaranteed to stay in the same room or on the same floor if you get re-admitted.

Q5. Can I change the room type if I get re-admitted?

A : Yes, you can indicate your preferred room type in the application form, but the result cannot be guaranteed. Postgraduate students will have the priority to get single rooms.
