Why Readmission (Round 1 Admission)

- Requirement by the University
- Every residential hall and college must practice readmission exercise every year.
- The quota is set by CEDARS every year.

Admission Committee

Processing Round I (re-admission) and Round II admission on behalf of the College Master

Committee Members

- Senior Resident Tutors
- Resident Tutors and Junior Resident Tutors
- UG and PG student representatives from college advisory committee
- SHC Affiliate Appointed by the College Master (including but not limit to Junior Resident Fellows)

Who needs to apply for Round I Admission?

- **Current residents** who wish to stay in the college next academic year or stay after September.
- **Current residents** who will be on exchange in the 1st semester of the next academic year but wish to return to the college in the 2nd semester.
- **Current residents** who will be on exchange next academic year but wish to return to the college in the year after the next academic year.
- **Previous residents** who are currently on exchange but wish to return to the college in the next academic year.

Round I Admission Criteria

1. High table dinner (10%)

Number of Absence ≤ 1 , 2, ≥ 3 : 10, 5, 0 points

2. Academic merit (35%)

GPA, Distinction/Pass/Fail, Prizes, Awards, Scholarship, Publications, etc...

3. Extracurricular activities (55%)

Within the College

– activity proposal deadline 15 March, event date before 15 April

Outside the College (35% max)

4. Special Consideration

Medical reason, financial reason, etc with valid proof

Non-compliance with college rules will affect chance of readmission

Floor Peer Review

P-1 Policy

- Residents whose residential years are equal to or exceed the normative study period minus one year (P-1) will be given the lowest priority when they apply for residency.
- Exceptions for special circumstances will be considered on a case-by-case basis, with the recommendations from the Warden and endorsement from the Chairman and Vice-chairman of the Committee on Halls. (C.O.H. 18.4.2024)

UG ~53%

PG ~60%

Important Dates 2025 (TBC)

5-10 April : Internal application period (google form)

10-17 April : Official application period (through HKU Portal)

23-26 April: Interview dates

May 5, 2025 (Mon) – May 27, 2025 (Tue) (Revision and assessment period)

26 May: Result announcement of Round 1 Admission

26-29 May: Appeal period (Unsuccessful applicants)

Late May- Early June: Review of appeals (appeal interview may be conducted)

6 June: Appeal results to students

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. What can I do if I do not get re-admitted?

A: Appeal, central clearing round admission.

Q2. Will my extracurricular activities outside colleges be counted?

A : Yes, both extracurricular activities within and outside the college will be taken into consideration.

Q3. What if I am not in Hong Kong during the assigned interview time slot?

A : Zoom interview can be arranged if you are not in HK.

Frequently Asked Questions

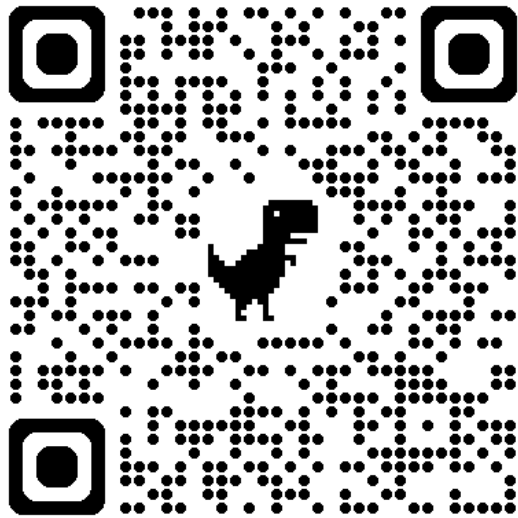
Q4. Will I stay in the same room or on the same floor if I get re-admitted?

A: You might be assigned to another floor. You are not guaranteed to stay in the same room or on the same floor if you get re-admitted.

Q5. Can I change the room type if I get re-admitted?

A : Yes, you can indicate your preferred room type in the application form, but the result cannot be guaranteed. Postgraduate students will have the priority to get single rooms.
